

- Submit WCC application, high school transcript, copy of high school diploma or GED and application fee to Admissions Office
- Submit immunization/meningitis records to Health Office (fax 914-606-6423). If not, you cannot register for classes
- Apply EARLY for financial aid (914-606-6773)
- Submit disability documentation to Disabilities Services office (IEP and triennial or doctor's note) by confidential fax (914-606-7893) or mail documentation to our office (LIBRARY G51) **not Admissions**. Ask high school guidance office to do this
- Call Disabilities office (914-606-6287) to make Extended Time Placement Test appointment for testing with accommodations (Testing accommodations will **not** be available at other times)
- Call Counseling Office (914-606-6572) for an appointment with an academic advisor to make your class schedule. Register **EARLY** to get the schedule you want and to avoid long lines
- Pay tuition by deadline (see WCC website www.sunywcc.edu)
- Register for services 1st week of **EVERY** semester for letters to your professors – not automatic
- Come early and come often
- First semester is NOT the time to go it alone without your accommodations
- Student must self-disclose to Disability Services and professors
