Income Guidelines for the Fall 2012-Spring 2013 Academic Year

The table below lists financial eligibility requirements for EOP admission during the 2012-2013 academic year. To be economically disadvantaged, a student must belong to a household that is defined in Category A, B, or C or the exceptions noted below. **Household Income Categories**

Household Size (Including head of household)	Total Annual Income in Previous Calendar Year

For each additional family member add \$7,326

Exceptions to Income Guidelines:

- The student's family is the recipient of Family Assistance or Safety Net payments through the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance; or through a county Department of Social Services; or Family Day Care payments through the New York State Office of Children and Family Assistance;
- The student lives with foster parents who do not provide support for college and the student's natural parents provide no such support;
- The student is a ward of the state or county
