

## **FALL 2010 FINANCIAL AID INSTRUCTIONS**

Your award letter represents **anticipated aid which is not final** until you have begun attendance in all of your classes. Withdrawal from classes or failure to attend classes will affect your final award offer. **MAKE SURE THAT YOU CHECK WITH YOUR FINANCIAL AID COUNSELOR BEFORE YOU DROP OR WITHDRAW FROM ANY OF YOUR CLASSES.** If you change your plans about attending, you must withdraw in person **before the first day of the semester** or you will be responsible for your bill. Aid cannot be applied to classes you never attended. Attendance is verified.

You **MUST** pay any difference on your bill which is not covered by the award letter or else your classes will be **DELETED**.

**FEDERAL GRANTS** - can be used to pay your bill.

**FEDERAL DIRECT LOANS** – Stafford Loans can be used to meet your bill, less 0.5%, which is deducted to cover origination fees. **FEDERAL PLUS LOANS** may also be used to meet your bill minus 2.5% which is used to cover origination fees.

**FEDERAL WORK STUDY** - is earned as you work and cannot be used to pay bills or charge books.

**BOOKSTORE CHARGES** - You may charge up to \$800 in books during the first two weeks of the semester if funds remain in your account after tuition and fees are met. If you only award is TAP/APTS may not be used for books.

**REFER TO PROGRESS AND PURSUIT STANDARDS ENCLOSED FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION on maintaining your eligibility for student financial assistance.**

**REFUNDS** - Any FPELL, FSEOG, FEDERAL LOANS and EOP FUNDS not used to cover tuition, fees and books should be available on the following dates depending on when your aid was processed. (TAP AND APTS funds not used to cover tuition are usually available at later dates. Check with the BURSAR'S OFFICE as to when you may expect refunds for these programs).
